### Guidance for this examination

### Examination structure

There are two sections to the examination paper:

*Section A* Consists of six questions.  
Candidates should attempt to answer three questions.  
Total allocation of marks is 30 marks.  
Suggested time allocation is 30 minutes.

*Section B* Consists of four questions.  
Candidates should attempt to answer two questions.  
Total allocation of marks is 70 marks.  
Suggested time allocation is 90 minutes.
